There are Council finger signs, etc. where path meets or crosses PFP.19 when quarry closed down motor cycle scramblers moved into the area. Wire fence erected in summer 2007 was shortly torn down and not replaced – was put up to stop motor bikes accessing the quarry.
Melyvn Mycock	1999 to present day pleasure/walking on foot 2 days a week (10 years)	Says there were stiles on the route
Susan Mycock	April 2008 to present date Pleasure and dog walks, weekly on foot (1 year)	
Mrs. Weston	1999 to January 2009 pleasure/weekly/on foot (10 years)	Has seen motorbikes/scramblers on route
B.J. Weston	1999 to present day. Pleasure/weekly/on foot (10 years)	Someone put a mesh fence up to stop the motor bikes getting in, but it was quickly torn down. Mentions footpath notices and indicators near the way
Andrew Ian Brown	1995 to present Pleasure/ every 2-3 weeks on foot. (14 years)	



Eric Beardmore	1946 to present day. Pleasure/weekly five times/on foot.  (63 yrs)	Stile put up in 2007. Gate has always been there. Gate was always open until last year-2007. The path has never gone through the gate. The path is to the side of gate. In 2007 (at point A on his map) a 2-bar iron fence was put up to stop motor bike scramblers accessing the Quarry at the same time a stile was put up against the iron fence.
Paul Brassington	1970 to date pleasure/weekly foot and horse back (39 years)	Have been stiles on the way Stiles erected 2007
Angela Salt	1991 to 2005 Pleasure 3 times a year on foot (14 years)	On some occasions would leave path to pick up Footpath 19 to complete walk.
M.W. Salt	1991 to 2005 Pleasure 3 times a year on foot (13 years)	Occasionally took the public Footpath 19 at halfway point along the path, but mostly continued to Harplow Lane
T.C. Goodwin	1985 to date Pleasure/weekly/ On foot  (24 years)	Sometimes cuts off route to join PFP No. 19.
Linda Marrow	1974 to current Pleasure/weekly/on foot  (35 years)	Stile put up mid-summer 2007. Path doesn't go through gates. Motor bikes were using path so a mesh fence was erected - Summer 2007, but was torn down shortly after. Many local people use this path – it is part of a popular walk on the outskirts of Cheadle.
Nicholas Thorley	1994 – 2009 weekly on foot  (15 years)	Stiles – has marked position on map Fence intended to prevent motorcycle access to quarry Marked at point on his map
M. Barlow	1968 to present 12 times a year on foot  (41 years)	Stiles erected 2007



Glynis Fallows	1958 to present used last 5 years daily on foot  (49 years)	Stile erected 2007 Steel fence and wire mesh on ground erected last year, marked position on map. Has used the path for many years for visiting friends at Gun End.
William Towle	1979 to present Pleasure Monthly/foot (30 years)	Directional arrow (County Council) sited on PFP 19
Christina Wright	1962 to 2008 Pleasure on horseback and with dogs and on foot (46 years)	
Kevin Barlow	1980 to present day walking/monthly/ on foot (28 years)	
Stephanie Hulme	1983 to present pleasure/monthly foot and horseback (26 years)	Has walked and ridden on horseback for 25 years.
Anthony Mairs	1980 -2007 seasonal on foot (27 years)	Only used part of the claimed route. Joined PFP 19 along the route.
Edward Beech	1937-1954 Weekly on foot (17 years)	Only used part of claimed route Joined PFP 19 along to the route.
Mark Weston	2004-2010 Seasonally on foot (6 years)	Refers to stiles on route but does not indicate where they are on the plan
David Curran	1960-2010 Weekly on foot (50 years)	Refers to stiles on route and has marked the location on plan.



David Grazier	2008-2014 Daily on foot (6 years)	Refers to stiles on route but has not indicated the position of them on the plan.
Barry Spooner	1986-2017 Seasonally on foot (31 years)	Refers to stiles on the route and has indicated the location on the plan. Also refers to signs being put up by new owners of the wood.
