## **Recommendation**

## **Background**

2. Staffordshire and Stoke-on-Trent Air Quality Project was launched in July 2018 after a successful bid to Defra under their Air Quality Grant Scheme and Defra awarded £208,000 to the partnership in April 2018.
3. This bid and current work came about after Alan White and Richard Harling asked for an Air Quality Briefing in July 2017 and an Air Quality Report came to the Health and Wellbeing Board December meeting in 2017. The bid included 4 elements which include Business and School engagement, EV scoping and communications/behaviour change.
4. The project partnership includes all the Districts and Boroughs, Stoke-on-Trent City Council and Staffordshire County Council. A Project Board was established and now meets quarterly. There is a detailed project plan with quarterly milestones and the projects governance is through the Staffordshire and Stoke-on-Trent Air Quality Forum and Staffordshire's Health & Wellbeing Board.
