## Recommendations

1. The Board is asked to:
  - a. Continue to provide system leadership, in Staffordshire, for the Families Strategic Partnership and seek an update at the September Board
  - b. Develop a clear line of sight to the STP Prevention workstream
  - c. Actively Support the implementation of Supportive Communities
  - d. Provide leadership for the production of more targeted JSNA starting with an examination of how we can better target people on the cusp of coming into health and care
  - e. Re- energise a programme of Public Conversations – agree a forward programme
  - f. Leadership of the Health in all Policies agenda

## Background

2. The Health and Wellbeing Board has a statutory function, as follows
  - a. To understand the key health and care issues in Staffordshire - The “Joint Strategic Needs Assessment” (JSNA).

  - b. Develop a Joint Health and Wellbeing Strategy
  - c. Partnerships: Bring organisations together by encouraging organisations to share budgets, and to cooperate when they buy health and care services.
  - d. Public engagement: Talk to the public and to have more honest public discussions about what affects health and wellbeing, and what is affordable in future.
  - e. Accountability: Ensure that health and care services are accountable to elected representatives (Councillors).
3. The Health and Wellbeing Board Strategy agreed in 2018 had a vision to help more people stay well for longer.
4. The appendices to this report suggest a key focus for the Board and some specific areas of activity. It also introduces Supportive Communities, which is in line with the Strategy.
