




#### Incidents, Transports & Conveyance Rate Year on Year




#### Staffordshire Hospital Handover Delays >15mins (inc cohorting) - Total Hours by Month




#### **Operational Demand & Handover Delays**







# Hospital Handover Delays > 15mins and Cohorting vs Operational Performance Cat 2 (mean 18mins & 90% 40mins)








#### **Lost Hours outside RSUH (UHNM)**

#### National position (up to and including September 2023)



Category-2 incidents saw response times slow for both measures. The Mean increased to 37-and-a-half minutes, and the 90<sup>th</sup> Centile to one-hour and 21-minutes. Although both slower than their relevant national standards, equally these times are faster than those recorded in September 2022.
