#### 84. Driver Training Panel Framework Contract

Reasons for the Decision – To consider establishing a framework agreement with fifteen National Driver Offender Retraining Scheme (NDORS) licenced driver trainers to enable the delivery of NDORS courses within Staffordshire.

## 85. Dynamic Purchasing System Contract Award for the Provision of Supported Living and Building Based Day Services
