## 1910 Finance Act. (Kew, London)

The claimed path is shown passing through <sup>O.S.</sup> plots 230, 96, 100, 101, 49 + 198.

The field book entry for 712 and 728 indicates a public footpath through O.S. plots 230, 96, 100, 101 + 49. The field book entry for the remainder of the path through O.S. plot 198 (145) is for an "alleged public footpath". However it is fair to say that because a £20 deduction is claimed for this path, that it was public.
