

I, xxxxxxxx a Member of Staffordshire County Council agree to abide by the Members' Code of Conduct, including the General Undertaking, as approved on 19 July 2012 and give notice of:

**Section A: The following disclosable pecuniary interests in accordance with Section 30 of the Localism Act 2011**

**Note: For the purposes of this section, 'Partner' is defined as your spouse, or civil partner, a person with whom you are living as husband and wife, or a person with whom you are living as if you are civil partners (but only where you are aware that your partner has the interests)**

**1. Employment, office, trade, profession or vocation** (Note: Any employment, office, trade, profession or vocation carried on for profit and gain.)

**2. Sponsorship** (Note: Any payment or provision of any other financial benefit (other than from the County Council) made or provided within the relevant period in respect of any expenses incurred by me or my partner in carrying out duties as a member or towards my election expenses in the last 12 months.)

**3. Contracts** (Note: Any contract which is made between the me or my partner (or a body in which I or my partner has a beneficial interest) and the County Council- (a) under which goods or services are to be provided or works are to be executed; and (b) which has not been fully discharged.)

**4. Land** (Note: Any beneficial interest in land which is within the area of the County Council)

5. **Licences** (Note: Any licence (alone or jointly with others) to occupy land in the area of the County Council for a month or longer)

7. **Securities** (Note: Any beneficial interest in securities of a body where –

(a) that body (to my knowledge) has a place of business or land in the area of the County Council; and

(b) either -

(i) the total nominal value of the securities exceeds £25,000 or one hundredth of the total issued share capital of that body; or

(ii) if the share capital of that body is of more than one class, the total nominal value of the shares of any one class in which I or my partner have a beneficial interest exceeds one hundredth of the total issued share capital of that class.

When an agenda item, or the resulting debate relates to anything listed above, the member must declare that interest and leave the meeting.

### 8. Personal Wellbeing or Financial Position

You also have a pecuniary interest where you attend a meeting of the Council where the business concerns your personal wellbeing or financial position or that of your partner to a greater extent than the majority of residents affected by the decision.

*You will only know this when you attend a meeting of the Council and an item on the agenda affects you or your spouse/partner to the extent described. You must then*

*declare the interest at the beginning of the meeting or before the item is discussed and not take part in the meeting for that item.*

**Section B: The following 'Other Interests' in accordance with Section 28(2) of the Localism Act 2011**

**Formal Bodies:**

**Under this section you have a personal interest in any business of the authority which relates to any body that you are a member of, or hold a position of general control or management and:**

- **have been appointed to, or nominated as a member of, by your Authority or**
- **exercises functions of a public nature or**
- **is directed to charitable purposes or**
- **has the principal purpose of influencing public opinion or policy (including Political Party or Trades Union)**

When any item listed under Section B is being considered at a Council meeting you must declare the interest but can take part in discussions and any vote on the item.
