## Schedule 1.

### Public Carriage Roads.

In accompanying sheet delineate the  
Townships of Chare & Charway Lane  
(including Chare Heath) with their  
& Hungerford Farm together with the  
various Roads set out in the  
the accompanying

The Roads coloured green on the map  
are those in respect of which in the  
Township of Charway Lane & those  
coloured Red are the disputed Roads  
lying in the Township of Chare.

The whole of the Roads are Public  
Roads and all lie within the Township  
Charway Lane & in part thereof within  
of the parishes, the Inhabitants  
thereof are hereby charged with the  
charge & joined together in that respect  
It is also to be noticed that the  
parish of Abenjusta Chare is within  
the Parish of Abenjusta & the  
Hungerford Farm in the said parishes  
and that the Inhabitants of Charway Lane  
in which the Roads wholly lie are not  
joined in the repairs thereof in for the  
Roads in the Township of Chare.

Some Roads lie in the Township of Chare  
the Parish of repairing them has  
been exclusively granted by the  
Inhabitants thereof -  
The Road designated by the Letter R;  
is not a Public Highway but an Ancient  
right of occupation only.

The whole of these Roads lie in the  
Township of Charway Lane, with the  
exception of those which are charged upon the  
Inhabitants of Chare and Abenjusta  
the Parish of the Township of  
Charway Lane in which they respectively  
wholly or partly lie.

The Roads designated by the Letters  
and F are only occupation Road  
belonging to particular Land.
