1. I am directed by the Secretary of State for the Environment to say that consideration has been given to the report of his Inspector, Mr J W Vernon, CMG, MA, Barrister, who held a local inquiry into the draft revision prepared by the Council under Part IV of the National Parks and Access to Countryside Act 1949 and the Countryside Act 1968 for the former Cheadle Rural District Council.

4. The Inspector recommended that:-

RP8 CAVERSWALL	The reclassification of this road used as a public path (hereinafter referred to as RUPP) should remain as a footpath in the Draft Revised Map and Statement.
RP11 CAVERSWALL RP9 CAVERSWALL	The reclassification of these RUPPs should remain as byways in the Draft Revised Map and Statement.
RP64/65 CAVERSWALL RP22 FORSBROOK	The reclassifications of these RUPPs should remain as footpaths in the Draft Revised Map and Statement.
RP55 CHEADLE RP40 CHECKLEY RP19 DILHORNE RP1 DRAYCOTT	The reclassifications of these RUPPs as footpaths in the Draft Revised Map and Statement should be altered to byways.

The Special Review preceded the Diversion Order and the reclassification as footpath in the Draft Revised Map and Statement should be altered to byway along the original route and consideration of the Diversion deferred until the next Review.


