
Alleged Public Bridle Ways at Goldenhill, Stoke-on-Trent

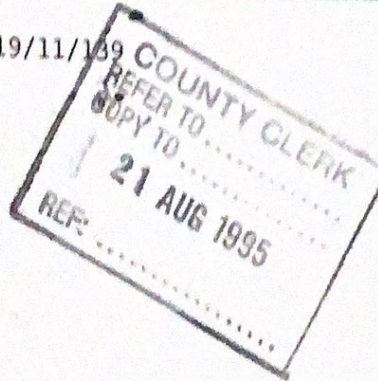
