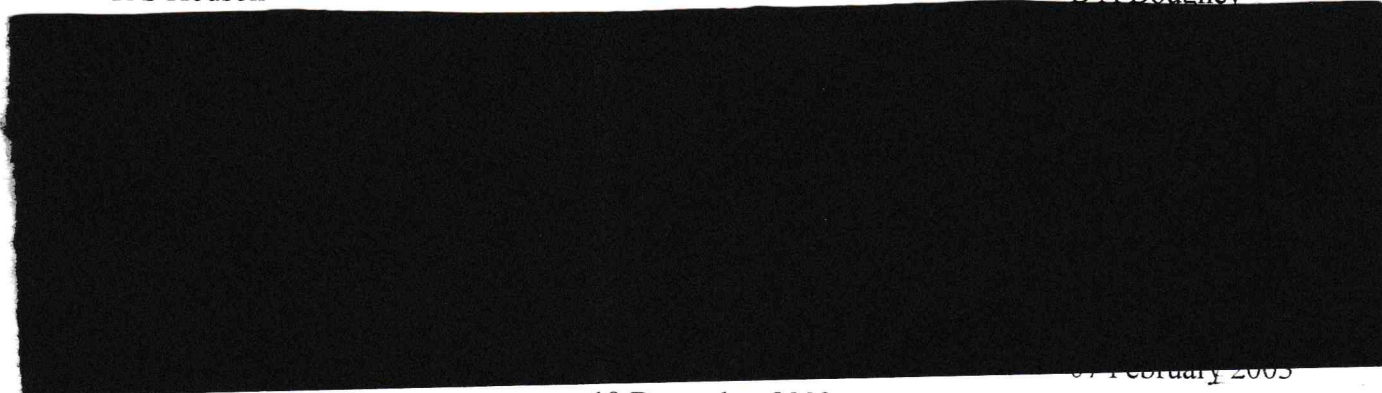

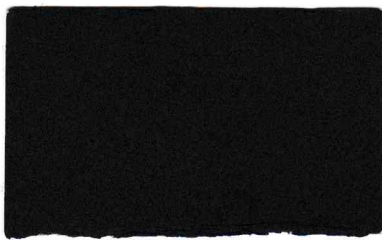
## **Application for an Alleged Public Footpath from No.15 Milwich to No.2 Leigh**

We have no information in the Parish that is not available elsewhere with regard to this matter.

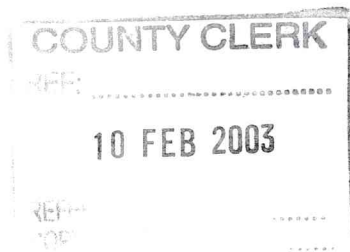
It is not recognised by parishioners as a footpath.

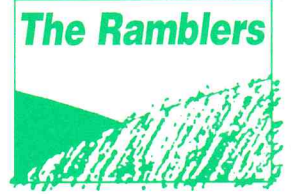
When this matter is investigated by yourselves could you please check on the status of the track between Highfields Farm and Overpark (highlighted on an enclosed copy of a definitive footpath map)

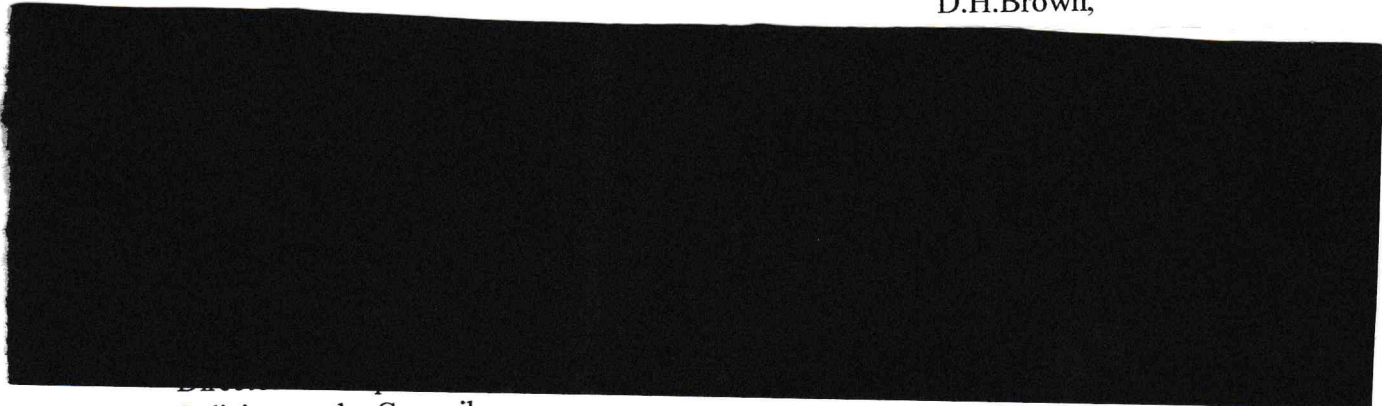

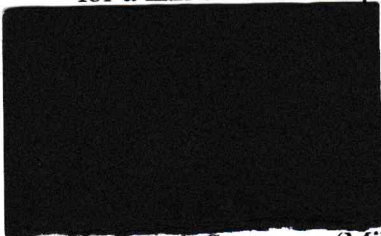
