

Public Carriage Roads forty feet wide - leading from Sandon in its present direction over Hardwick Heath towards Leek.
 Its present direction over the aforesaid Heath towards Leek.
 Leading from Stone in its present direction over the aforesaid Heath towards Uttoxeter.

Public Carriage Roads thirty feet wide -
 From Hardwick in a northwardly direction over the aforesaid Heath into the said Uttoxeter Turnpike Road -
 Branching out of the said Uttoxeter Turnpike Road in a northwardly direction over the said Heath into the ancient road leading towards Colwallen -
 From the Uttoxeter Turnpike road in a southwardly direction over Day Hills Common into the ancient road leading towards Small rise -

(Public foot Roads)

One foot road or way leading out of the Hardwick road at Hardwick in a northwardly direction over the allotment 10. into the Leek Turnpike road.
 One other foot road or way leading from Small rise in a northwardly direction over the allotment 17. into and across the Day Hills roads and from thence in the same direction over the allotment 19. and leading towards Milwich -

And I do hereby order and direct that the Owners or occupiers of the allotments over which the said foot roads or ways pass shall immediately put down good and proper Stiles in the fences belonging to his her or their several and respective allotments and at all times thereafter support and keep the same in good repair -

Allotments for watering places and getting Stone &c
 Two acres one rood and twelve perches near Hardwick bounded northwardly and eastwardly by the allotment 10. and westwardly and southwardly by the Hardwick road -

One acre one rood and twenty seven perches adjoining the Uttoxeter " " Turnpike road bounded eastwardly westwardly and southwardly by the allotment 10. and northwardly by the Uttoxeter Turnpike road -

And I do hereby direct and appoint that the said Allotments so set out and allotted by me as aforesaid are for the purpose of public watering places for cattle and for digging and getting Stone Gravel Sand and other materials for the making or repairing the Bridges Highways and roads within the said parish of Sandon to be used in common by the proprietors of Estates within the same parish and their Tenants for the time being for and in respect of their Estates within the same parish and that the herbage growing and renewing in and upon the said Allotments subject at all times to getting Stone as hereinbefore mentioned shall be vested in the owner for the time being of the allotment No 10. And I do also order and direct that he or she shall not at all times in consideration thereof maintain and keep in repair the fences
