Inclosing Lands in the Parish of *Sandon*, in the  
County of *Stafford*.

[ROYAL ASSENT, 18 May 1814.]

**W**H E R E A S there are within the Parish of *Sandon*, in  
the County of *Stafford*, certain Commons and Waste  
Grounds, containing by Estimation, Three hundred  
Acres, or thereabouts: Preamble.

And whereas the Right Honourable *Dudley* Earl of *Harrowby* is  
Lord of the Manor of *Sandon*, and as such is the Owner of the  
Soil of all the Commons and Waste Grounds within the same Manor,  
and is also entitled to an ancient Rabbit Warren thereupon: Lord of the Manor.

And whereas the said Earl is Patron of the Vicarage of the  
Parish Church of *Sandon* aforesaid; and *George Bonney*, Clerk, is  
Vicar and present Incumbent of the said Vicarage: Patron and Vicar.

And whereas the said *Dudley* Earl of *Harrowby*, *George Bonney*,  
Clerk, and *James Wooldridge*, and several other Persons, are  
Proprietors of, or interested in the said Commons and Waste  
Grounds: Proprietors.

And whereas an Act was passed in the Forty-first year of the  
Reign of His present Majesty King *George* the Third, intituled,  
An Act for consolidating in one Act, certain Provisions usually
