

...died; and that the Share or Shares of the Person or Persons so dying, shall be allotted to the Person or Persons who shall by Law become entitled to the same, and shall be accepted and fenced by him her or them, according to the Directions of this Act or the said recited Act, and he she or they shall be liable to the Charges and Expences and other Conditions of this Act and the said recited Act.

No Turf to be cut without leave of Commissioner.

And be it further Enacted, That it shall not be lawful for any Person whomsoever, from and after the passing of this Act, until the execution of the Award of the said Commissioner, to cut, dig, pare, flay, get or carry away any Turf, Soil, Heath, Gorse, Gravel, Sand, Stone or Dung, in upon or from the said Commons and Waste Grounds intended to be divided and inclosed, or any part thereof, without the Licence of the said Commissioner first obtained in writing under his hand, which Licence (except as to Turf Soil and Dung) the said Commissioner is hereby empowered to grant under such Rules and Restrictions as he shall think proper; and if any Person shall after the passing of this Act, cut, dig, pare, flay, get or carry away any Turf, Soil, Heath, Gorse, Gravel, Sand, Stone or Dung, in upon or from such Commons and Waste Grounds, or any part thereof, without such Licence of the said Commissioner, or having obtained such Licence shall act in any manner contrary thereto, every such Person shall for every such Offence forfeit and pay any sum of Money not exceeding the Sum of Five Pounds, the same to be levied recovered and applied in such manner as Penalties and Forfeitures are by the said recited Act directed to be levied, recovered and applied.

Commissioner may divert Roads through old Inclosures.

And be it further Enacted, That the said Commissioner shall, and he is hereby authorized and required in all cases where in his judgment it shall appear to be requisite and proper, or for the more convenient Occupation of the Lands and Hereditaments within the said Parish, to divert and turn any old or accustomed public Road Way or Path, passing or leading through or over any part of the old Inclosures within the said Parish of Sandon, or to stop up or to discontinue any such Roads Ways and Paths as to the said Commissioner shall seem meet and proper: Provided always, that no such Road Way or Path shall be diverted, turned, stopped up, or discontinued, without the Concurrence and Order of Two Justices, and subject to such Appeal as is mentioned or referred to in and by the said recited Act.
