Description of route :

Path leaves Stone - Hilderstone Road a little east of X-roads, near edge of Hardwick Heath. Path follows field side of hedge : rails (with barbed wire) at road, then second set of rails, and to rails where there are remains of stile. Path then enters the wood, crosses heath, then Tolpool Brook by a foot-bridge (partly washed away) and climbs out of wood in a SW. direction. It leaves the wood by rails near a fallen (but still living) oak tree, then follows route shown on map to reach lane near Hardwick Farm along the remains of two lines of trees and bushes to a F.G.
