Nature of Objection:

Omission of path: **From S end of Roashes (paths 41 and 45), going NE**
To road about $\frac{1}{4}$ mile E of Shaw Cottage
 From
 To (i) Bend in F.P. 41 S. of the Roashes
 (ii) F.P. 45 about 180 yds from its SW. end

Observations by County Planning Department:

The claimed path links at its northern end with county road D.45. At its south western end it divides into two and one leg links with admitted path F.P.41 south of Rockhall and the other links with admitted path F.P.45 south east of Rockhall.

The whole path is shown on the 6" O.S. Map as a footpath.

Claimed path obj.1792 depends on the inclusion of this path and should be considered with it.
