WHEREAS at this present Adjourned Quarter Sessions of the Peace Major R.F.P. Monckton made application to the Court for a declaration under Section 31(1)(a) of the above-named Act that on the 24th day of July, 1954 there was no public right of way over the land forming the site of that part of footpath 0.1046 from its junction with footpath 0.1048 southwards to its junction with footpath 0.1004 as shewn on the Provisional Map prepared under the National Parks and Access to the Countryside Act, 1949 for the Parish of Penkridge in the Rural District of Cannock in the County of Stafford.

The Court of Quarter Sessions having heard the said application declared that on the 24th day of July, 1954 there was no public right of way over the land forming the site of that part of footpath 0.1046 in the Parish of Penkridge from its junction with footpath 0.1048 southwards to its junction with footpath 0.1004.
