### **Health and Wellbeing Board Strategy – Comparative Health Metrics and Performance Indicators Update**

#### **Recommendations**

#### **Background**

1. At the Health and Wellbeing Board (HWBB) in March 2023, to support the monitoring of the HWBB Strategy, baseline data was provided for a number of comparative health metrics and performance indicators.
2. For each of the four priority areas in the strategy a lead was assigned, with agreement that each priority would be the focus for discussion in more depth at a different quarterly meeting - including discussion of the associated metrics/indicators.
3. At the March 2023 meeting the lead officer for the priority 'Good Mental Health' suggested that there might be further metric/s for their area to be included in future quarterly data updates.

#### **Updates**

4. Since the March meeting, discussions have taken place with the lead for the 'Good Mental Health' priority area and one further metric has been added:
5. New referrals to secondary mental health services for those under 18 years of age.
