## The Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012

**Notice is hereby given** under Regulation 10 of The Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012 that the Cabinet, at their meeting 21 September 2016, are to be requested to take a Key Decision in respect of approving *The Stafford Office Moves Project for the relocation of staff based in central Stafford.* 

**And whereas** the Chairman of the Council's Corporate Review Committee has been notified by the Proper Officer of the intention to make the aforementioned Key Decision in accordance with Regulation 10.

Regulation 9 of The Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012 provides that where the Cabinet propose to make a key decision, that decision must not be made until at least 28 clear days public notice has been given. Where it is not possible to give 28 clear days' notice, Regulation 10 of the above Regulations require that the Council must make available at its offices, and publish on its website, a notice setting out the reasons why compliance with Regulation 9 is impracticable

## Reasons why compliance with Regulation 9 is impracticable -

This is an organisational matter rather than one that should directly impact the public, and if the Council is able to move quickly on this the savings available can be delivered earlier. It wasn't originally identified as a key decision as it was thought to simply involve moving staff from one building to another, but the proposal developed into a wider plan to manage the Council accommodation needs in Stafford.
