Their only concern is that if it is made a Bridleway, that no access be allowed to powered vehicles.





Thank you for your letter of December 15<sup>th</sup>, 2003. North Staffordshire Bridleways Association does not have any other Evidence to submit at this time. However we would wish to express great support for this Bridleway claim. If the Definitive status of the route was upgraded, it would be of great benefit to local horse riders as it connects two fairly good riding roads and is an alternative to having to ride along the busy A5103 main road—which is a feeder route to the nearby M6 junction. 

The documentary evidence appears to be conclusive in confirming this route as once capable of carrying horse drawn hicles and therefore a bridleway which was subsequently downgraded to a footpath.

The return to BP status would be of benefit to horse indees in this area, providing a safe and quiet with between Worston Lan and Cherry Lane.

The northern half of the FI is at present fenced off from a paddock. The footbadge over the book near Cherry Lane will need to be improved if the upgrading is approved.
