1910 FINANCE ACT.

This shows the eastern part of the claimed route between Three Mile Lane and Stoney Low Farm, separate from taxable land holdings.

The Field Book entry for hereditament 203 is for a 'right of way across farm'. There is only one track crossing 203. This is the claimed route.

I shall look for evidence for the western section of the route when I next visit London.

HIGHWAY-BRIDLEWAY DIVERSION ORDER Q1S13 MICH 1834.

The eastern end of the claimed route near to 3 mile Lane is the western end of the bridleway diverted on this order. The order creates a new line of bridleway, part of it being Ram Lane. Ram Lane is described on the plan as leading to Madeley. The route clearly crosses the Whitmore to Keele road at Ram Lane before reaching point A on the plan. Therefore this provides strong evidence that Ram Lane was a bridlewa
