Application for the upgrading of public footpath 73,

The Parish Council thank you for the notification of the application for bridleway status on this footpath, but do not support it. They consider that it has always been used at a footpath, and that if a bridleway is needed then it should be elsewhere. Access from Woodhouse Farm into Apedale was suggested as preferable.

They also object to the proposed diversion of the route (FP.39), and feel that prior consultation with the local authorities concerned should take place. Perhaps you could advise us on the general public's rights and powers concerning such applications?
