- 1. I am directed by the Secretary of State for the Environment to say that consideration has been given to the report of his Inspector, Mr J W Vernon, CMG, MA, Barrister, who held a local inquiry into the draft revision prepared by the Council under Part IV of the National Parks and Access to Countryside Act 1949 and the Countryside Act 1968 for the former Cheadle Rural District Council.
